



Governor's Award

OBJECTIVE – Leadership North Carolina is dedicated to the principle that informed and motivated individuals, acting as leaders, will be the most important factor in making our State a desirable place to live a productive, rewarding, and satisfying life. Leadership North Carolina, in carrying out its mission of developing informed, engaged and motivated leaders, will also recognize those citizens who have made profound contributions to our communities and our State.

The Governor's Award is one such award, which is presented in honor of the current governor, who serves as the Honorary Chair of the Leadership North Carolina Board of Directors. The Governor's Award is Leadership North Carolina's highest honor and is given to a North Carolinian who serves as a leadership role model, and whose efforts have resulted in an improved quality of life for the citizens of our state.

AWARD CRITERIA – The Governor's Award is presented to a citizen of North Carolina whose demonstrated leadership has made a significant improvement in the quality of life, economic well-being and/or sense of community in our State.

Questions to consider when selecting a nominee include any or all of the following examples:

- *What are the nominee's most significant leadership roles in professional or civic activities?*
- *What are the nominee's leadership skills and characteristics?*
- *In what ways has the nominee had an impact on the economy and quality of life in his/her community and/or the state?*
- *How has the nominee impacted others?*
- *Why is the nominee deserving of this award?*

ELIGIBILITY AND SELECTION – Any citizen of North Carolina is eligible for the LNC Governor's Award with the exception of previous recipients (see page 2). **Alumnae/alumnus of the LNC program will submit nominations to the LNC Awards Committee who will then review each nomination and select the recipient.**

AWARD PRESENTATION

Recipients will be recognized during the Annual Graduation & Awards Ceremony May 13, 2010 at the North Carolina Capitol in Raleigh.
