



Stanley Frank Class Award

OBJECTIVE – The Leadership North Carolina program is dedicated to the principle that informed and motivated persons, acting as leaders, will be the most important factor in making our State a desirable place to live a productive, rewarding, and satisfying life. The Leadership North Carolina program, in carrying out its mission of developing engaged and informed leaders, will also recognize leadership “role models” as evidenced by their individual contributions to our communities and our State.

The Stanley Frank Class Award is one such award, which is presented in honor of the late Stanley Frank, one of the founders of Leadership North Carolina, who gave of his time, talent, and resources to make our State a better place to live and to work. Mr. Frank was a Greensboro businessman and a civic giant who was one of the earliest, and one of the strongest supporters of Leadership North Carolina. There are many organizations in the Greensboro community on which Stanley Frank left his mark. He was known as a compassionate, modest and generous gentleman.

Mr. Frank was the retired chairman and chief executive officer of Carolina By-Products. In addition to his corporate service, he chaired the Piedmont Triad Airport Authority, was a 36 year member of the Guilford College Board of Trustees, served as president of the United Community Services (now the United Way), chaired the Greensboro Chamber of Commerce and served on the board of Leadership North Carolina until he passed on January 2, 2006. Above all, Stanley Frank he was dedicated to providing opportunities to others in all that he did.

AWARD CRITERIA – The Leadership North Carolina Stanley Frank Class Award will be presented to a participant of the current Leadership North Carolina class whose demonstrated leadership has made a significant improvement in the quality of life, economic well-being and/or sense of community in our State.

ELIGIBILITY AND SELECTION – Any participant of the current Leadership North Carolina class is eligible for the LNC Stanley Frank Award. Participants in the current class of the LNC program may submit nominations for consideration by the LNC Awards Committee.
